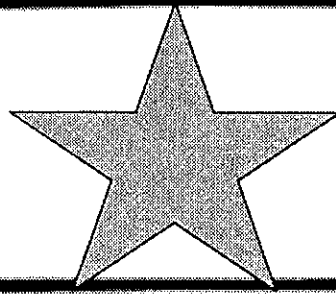

Reading and Language Arts

Phonics: silent consonants and /f/ sound (gh, ph)

Comprehension: Compare and contrast 2 or more versions of the same story, character point of view.

YOUTUBE is an amazing resource for read alouds! Listen to different versions of your favorite fairy tales!

Get moving! Go outside and play! Ride bikes, play outdoor games, jump on a trampoline. If you're stuck inside, play "the floor is lava," they love that!
