After thinking about it, Jasper decided he would give it a try.



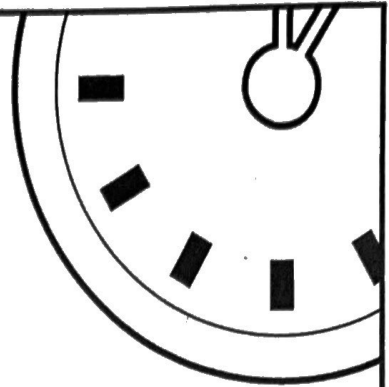

There is a place in New York City most people never see because it is 90 feet underground. It is a bank vault. A vault is a safe where banks keep their money. There are many banks in New York City. Some people think that New York City is the money capital of the world. All the banks want to keep their money safe from bank robbers.



One of the biggest of these banks is the Chase Manhattan Bank. When the bank decided to build a vault, it went underground. The hole dug to build the vault was big. It was the largest hole ever dug in New York City. Hundreds of loads of dirt had to be carried away as the hole was dug.

The Chase Manhattan Bank Building has five basements, one on top of the other. The vault is in the fifth basement. It looks like a giant room. It is all glass. The glass is bulletproof. There are armed guards inside the room.

The door of the vault weighs 45 tons. It is balanced on its hinges. You can open this 45-ton door with one finger if you know the combination. The door is locked by two combination locks and one time lock.

Usually armored trucks deliver money to banks. They stop in front of the bank. The driver stays in the truck. Police guard the truck. Armed men take the money into the bank, but this doesn't happen at the Chase Manhattan. The truck drives right into the basement. There is a special ramp that leads from the street into the basement. The truck is unloaded inside the bank. The Chase Manhattan's money is quite safe.
