ONLINE LEARNING

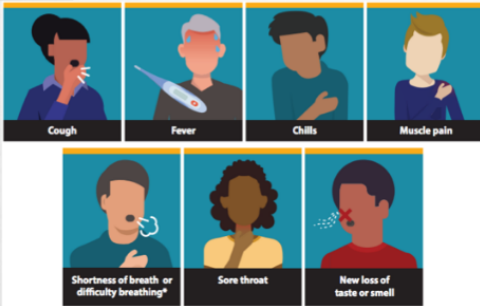
Students will learn with a full-time online option

Crooksville Exempted Village School District COVID-19 At Home Health Risk Assessment

The health and safety of the students and staff of the Crooksville Exempted Village School District is the number 1 priority of the district. In order to ensure the health and safety of all students and staff within the CEVSD, it is imperative that our Parents/Guardians screen students at home for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 prior to sending them to school.

Each morning screen your child for the following signs/symptoms of COVID-19:



Signs/symptoms can range from mild to severe illness.

If your child is experiencing multiple signs/symptoms, it is highly recommended that you keep your child at home and contact your child's school.

*Seek medical care immediately if your child has emergency warning signs of COVID-19.

- Trouble Breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face

Face Covering Policy



School Employees will be **REQUIRED** to wear a face covering/mask

Students in **K-12 are required** to wear a face covering/mask when entering the building, moving from location to location such as cafeteria, commons, restroom, recess, etc. and leaving the building unless they are unable to do so for health or developmental reasons. Masks are required where six feet social distancing is not feasible. We will incorporate mask breaks in the classroom for students. Mask exemptions will require a medical excuse from a doctor.

Students using Crooksville transportation are required to wear a mask or face covering
