Dear Crooksville community,

Crooksville Schools is committed to the safety and health of our students and staff. We want to inform you that we have recently received information about at least one confirmed case of COVID-19 in a student or staff person at Crooksville Elementary. Cleaning and disinfecting of the exposed locations has been completed.

We are working closely with the Perry county health department and anyone identified as a close contact will be notified as a part of the COVID-19 investigation.

## How You Can Help

Be proactive about reducing the number of interactions that students and staff have with one another by practicing social distancing (staying at least 6 feet apart) to limit the spread of COVID-19. In addition to physical distancing, these important tools help to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

- Stay home when you are sick
- Wear a mask or face covering while in public places or if people who don't live with you must visit your home.
- Avoid unnecessary gatherings with people who don't live in your home.
- Avoid sharing food, drinks, or utensils.
- Frequently wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue, and then dispose of the tissue and wash your hands immediately.
- Regularly clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipes.
